Youth and Vocational – Norm deGrussa

Olivier sadly leaves us on July 7th. Norm performed interviews to prospective student attendee Ryan Turner for National Youth Science Forum. Nice guy and hopefully will make it through the next round of District Interviews. He is a straight A student on all subjects. Olivier gave us his report of his past week. Sun, Sea Surf, what a life.

Guest speaker Joe Moniodis Topic Community project run through the Edmund Rice Centre. Joe is a Social trainer with the Edmund Rice Centre where they run Sports programs for both indigenous kids and African Refugee kids. These Children are referred to Edmund Rice centre through Relationships Australia for Whom our Debbie Singh works.

The idea is for the children who are a bit wayward to be brought into mainstream way of behaviour through discipline in sport.

The African kids are trained in Australian rules football , where the Indigenous Kids are trained in the round ball version of football , being Soccer.

The program for the indigenous kids has only been running six weeks and is showing early signs of success s, with one boy who hasn't been to school in over two years , finally finding purpose in life and attending once more.

There is a behavioral problem with kids aged 11 to 13 in Banksia Grove area whereas up in Butler the problems are shining through at a much earlier age of around 7 to 11.

What ever programs are introduced , they have got to be better than doing nothing.

Joe 's visit was to enlighten us to the project and to see support by way of donation to allow purchase of playing kit for the kids.
