### President Lin's Report

- Welcome to members and partners of the Group 7 Rotary Clubs of Burnside, Kent Town, Magill Sunrise, Norwood and St. Peters who have joined us tonight to hear Gemma Sisia. In total, we have 146 people attending the meeting – an outstanding turn-up.
- Thanks to **Garth**, and all club members and partners for a most successful 26<sup>th</sup> Campbelltown Art Show. The quality of the exhibits was excellent.

- The Club is delighted to be able to present Gemma Sisia with a cheque for \$5000 to go to the School of St. Jude.

### St. Jude's School, Tanzania: A Challenge to Us

Gemma Sisia, a country girl from NSW, is the founder and continuing champion of a remarkable school in Tanzania. After commencing in 2002 with two classrooms and three students, the School of St. Jude now provides free education to more than 1200 pupils and has one of the best academic records in the country. All funding for the school has been through Gemma's boundless energy and the support of many people from across the world. Rotary in Australia has been a strong supporter from the start.

Gemma's slogan is the simple but effective '*fighting poverty through education*'. Her school is for the very poorest children, the ones whose families cannot afford the clothes or books or even pencils to send them to the supposedly 'free' government schools. St Jude's provides everything, including uniforms and nourishing meals. The students, from illiterate parents, might otherwise remain trapped in the endless cycle of poor education, illiteracy and poverty. Selection of new students is by a rigorous testing process. Teachers are provided with a high level of mentoring and support. The objective is to give the children the opportunity to achieve successful, well paid careers in Tanzania.

The extreme poverty of the students' families has required the building of boarding school accommodation (Monday – Friday) for many students. With the continuing growth in student numbers, and with the older students having now completed primary school, a secondary school has also been started.

Gemma's story challenges us with the evidence of how the determination of one person can help change the world. Our Director for International Service, **Jane G.** will be pleased to provide more information on how you can assist Gemma and her school. Donations are tax deductible.
