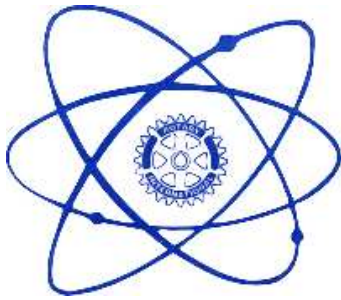
The Youth Parliament

Club member Damian Leach introduced an experienced "Youth Parliamentarian", 18 year old Myalls Fawcett who told us about his experiences with the Youth Parliament. This is an initiative of the YMCA with the specific objective of providing a forum for young people aged 16-25 to express their views, develop skills and learn about our democratic parliamentary system. Surveys have shown that our youth have a generally poor awareness of the workings of the Parliamentary system.

More than one thousand people have been educated about our parliamentary system of voting procedures, parliamentary etiquette, public speaking, bill writing, negotiating and bargaining with these skills being offered in a professional and challenging environment. This year, the five day residential program is to be held at Rostrevor College with participants being bussed to Parliament House for each of their four sitting days.

The views of the participants are often developed into a Youth Parliament bill, with participants working in teams of up to eight people to craft their proposed legislation. Each team's bill is debated during at least three full days in Parliament House.

In addition to the intensive parliamentary training, participants are offered other activities. These include a recreation program, attending the opening and closing ceremonies of Youth Parliament and a formal reception at Government House. The program is an approved Year 11 SACE program with successful participants being eligible to gain two SACE units by participating in the program and meeting other requirements. Tonight's Chairperson, Damian Leach, is the 2009 Youth Parliament Training Manager. Myalls is currently the Youth Parliament Deputy Leader of the Opposition, and hopes to become the Youth Parliament Governor in the coming year.
