

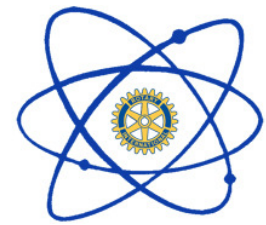

The issues that came out of the presentation by our guest speakers, Director of Membership, Bill Allan and Committeeman John Gardner were;

- Every existing member has a role in making nominations of prospective members,
- The requirements for classification are now less stringent,
- We should consider all of our circle of acquaintances as prospective Rotarians,
- Possible sources of nominations are sporting, social club, and church contacts, new neighbours, our friends' adult children, prospective retirees, women, parents of our kids' friends and so on.

The excellent video produced by the Rotary Club of Lane Cove, featuring the very experienced television presenter, Roger Climpson,

award winning news reader, and member of RC Lane Cove, helped to set the scene.

This video outlines general information about Rotary and some of its purpose and significant achievements. The video is clearly directed towards sparking interest in prospective members. This presents a potential problem if rotary persists with a policy of restricting membership by invitation only. It appears that some Clubs may be openly advertising for expressions of interest from the non-Rotarian public.

Achieving our objective of continued growth of membership may require some changes in our approach.

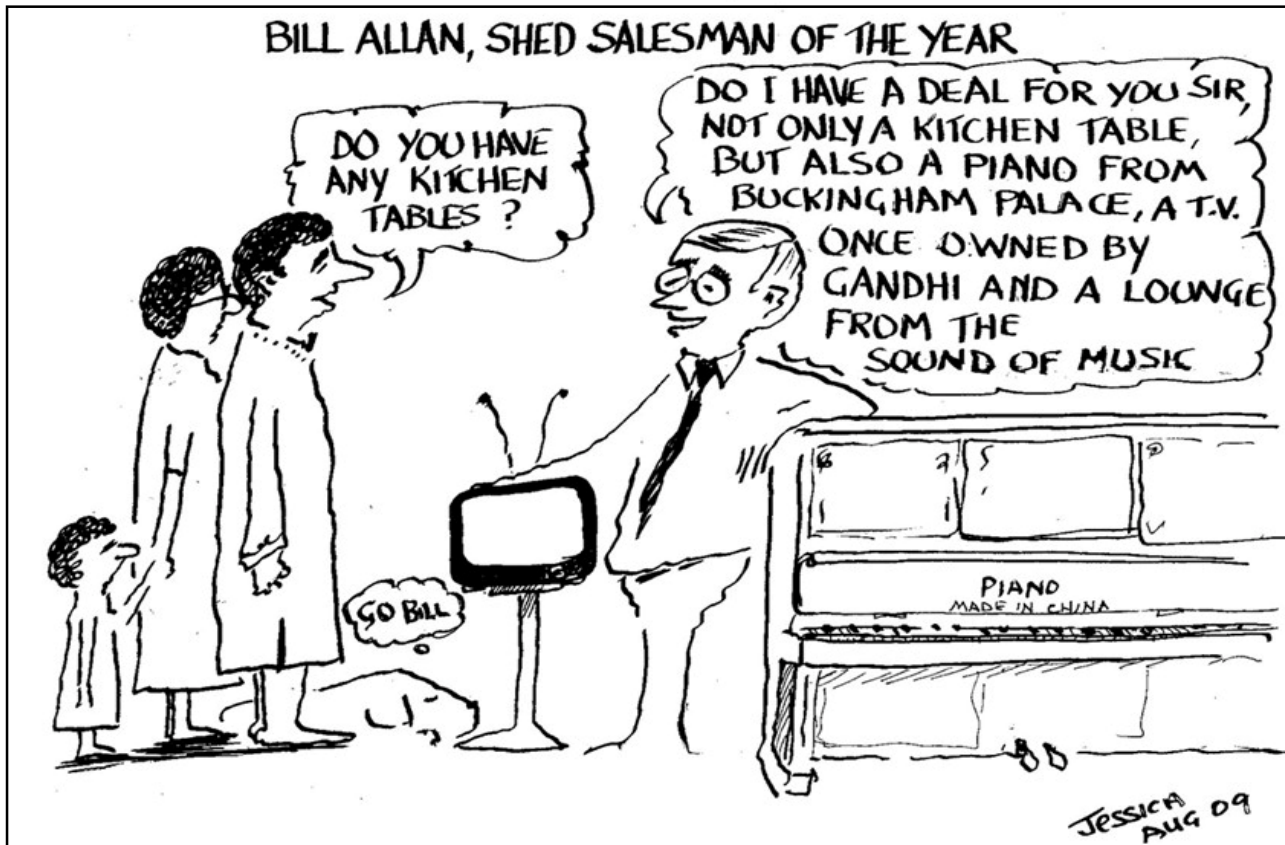
