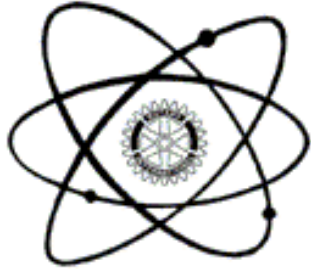
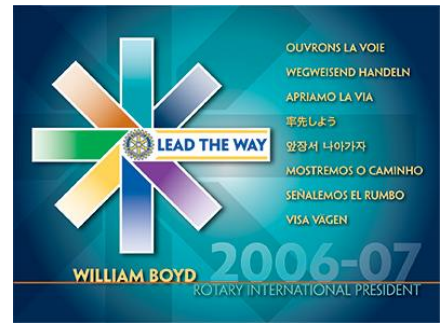

GUEST SPEAKER REPORT

Chairman David Tuckwell introduced Owen Bevan a fellow Rotarian from the Stirling club. This Rotary year he is Chairman of our District Public Relations Committee. To quote from the district handbook the committee "makes the public aware of Rotary activities & advises clubs on effective public relations".

The title of Owens's speech was deliberately provocative; **ROTARY HAS TEN MORE YEARS.**

It is intended to make us think about the wonderful organization to which we belong. Are we finished in 10 years? We need to be aware that we have a high proportion of members in the 50+ & 60+ age group. In 10 years many of us may be unable, unwilling or not available to contribute to Rotary in a viable way.

To meet the many challenges we face such as this Owen stressed two key areas that are mandatory for the success of any organization be it your business or Rotary. They are **ENTHUSIASM & VISION.**

As an organization we are unique as we operate at 3 levels; local, national, and international. This provides Rotary with a very wide dimension and scope. Being non political and non sectarian provides further strength. The Polio Plus program is just one example of our impact. If we combine this enthusiasm & vision with a strong awareness of world community issues Rotary has a future well beyond 10 years.

On this positive note John Thomas thanked Owen for an inspirational address.
