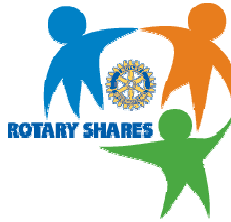

If not sold, prizewinning works remain the property of the Artist.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND SALE OF WORKS FOR PAINTINGS AND DRAWINGS

1. Each competitor may enter a maximum of three original uncopied works. The entry fee includes entry into the Open Section as well as entry into the Section which represents the major medium of the entry.
2. Each work must be **SUITABLY FRAMED** and be the original work of the competitor. **Works will be accepted up to a maximum of 1.5m² However, such works will incur a premium fee of \$40 per painting.** [Use screw eyes and picture wire. Use of alternative materials will result in the work not being hung. Works in excess of 1.5m² will be disqualified].
3. The competitor is asked to list the entries on form "A" in the order of priority for hanging so that if in the event of more works being received than hanging space is available, the artists preferred works can be selected for hanging. If required to be hung as a pair, please stipulate. Otherwise the order and placement within the gallery is at the discretion of Rotary.
4. Each work must have Section "B" of the Entry Form attached to the back.
5. Local Entry Awards must be from artists resident within the Murray Bridge Rural City Council area.
6. Each entrant must complete, sign and post section "A" to **Rotary Art Show, c/- Ron Jericho, 2 Leslie Street, Murray Bridge 5253**, with a cheque or money order at the rate of \$20.00 per entry, or \$40 where the painting is in excess of 1.2m². **IF A WORK IS NOT SELECTED FOR HANGING, THE ENTRY FEE IS NON REFUNDABLE.**
7. THE ROTARY CLUBS **RESERVE** THE RIGHT TO EXHIBIT SUCH OF THE ENTRIES AS THE CLUBS SELECT for the period the show is open to the public, and the Clubs shall be entitled to offer any entry for sale to the public at the price endorsed on the work and, in the event of a sale being effected, the Clubs shall be entitled to **retain twenty-five per centum of the sale price (exclusive of any GST)** as a selling commission. Artists registered for GST will receive the GST component to be forwarded to the Australian Taxation Office
8. **No work shall be awarded more than one prize.** Winners will be posted on the Murray Bridge website at:- www.rotarnet.com.au/murraybridge
9. The judge or judges of the competition will inspect all entries, and shall be such person or persons as are selected and appointed by the Rotary Clubs of Mobilong and Murray Bridge. The judge's or judges' decision shall be final.
10. The clubs will exercise all reasonable care in handling the entries submitted, but will not be responsible for the loss of, or damage to any entries while in the custody of the Clubs or Clubs' agents or being sent to or from the Art Show. **ARTISTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR INSURING THEIR WORKS AGAINST LOSS OR DAMAGE.**
11. **SPECIAL NOTE:** Entries must be delivered free of all charges. No payments whatsoever will be made by the Clubs for freight, or other charges incurred in delivery or return.
12. NOT acceptable for entry are works in beaten copper, batik, poker work, bark arrangements, plaster relief, collages, photographs or wet paintings.
13. If a competitor fails to remove his or her entry or entries from the designated address as provided in these conditions, the Clubs, after sending by registered post to the competitor at his or her known address one month's notice of the Club's intention to sell or otherwise dispose of such entries, or in the event of the address of the competitor being not known to the Clubs, then one month after advertising notice of such intention in a newspaper, may sell such entry or entries and, after deducting for the proceeds the costs of any incidentals to the sale, shall hold any balance for the competitor PROVIDED however that in the event of such entry or entries being in the opinion of the Clubs unsaleable, the clubs may, in lieu of selling the same, destroy or otherwise dispose of it or them in such a manner as the Clubs may deem fit and thereafter the Clubs shall be under no liability whatever to the competitor in respect of any entry so destroyed or disposed of. Any notice sent by post as aforesaid shall be deemed to have been received by the competitor on the date when it would have been delivered in the ordinary course of post.
14. The Clubs may allow any entries to be reproduced in Newspapers, Magazines, the Show Catalogues, Exhibition web site, or by Television or otherwise used for promotional purposes.
15. ENTRIES WILL BE RECEIVED AT THE **MURRAY BRIDGE REGIONAL GALLERY**, SITUATED IN THE TOWN HALL, SIXTH STREET, MURRAY BRIDGE, **FROM 9-00 A.M. MONDAY 7 APRIL 2008 AND NO LATER THAN 5PM THE SAME DAY.** IF NOT DELIVERED BY HAND, CONSIGN BY BUS, OR AIR FREIGHT TO MURRAY BRIDGE REGIONAL GALLERY, TOWN HALL, SIXTH STREET, MURRAY BRIDGE, SO AS TO ARRIVE BEFORE 1-00 P.M. ON 7 APRIL 2008.
16. ENTRIES MUST BE COLLECTED FROM THE REGIONAL GALLERY, MURRAY BRIDGE, FROM 10.00AM. TO 1PM SATURDAY 26 APRIL 2008.
17. All works must be for sale. Artists are reminded that price is an important consideration in sales, and should represent good value for the purchaser.
18. THE CLUBS WILL NOT ACCEPT RESPONSIBILITY FOR INCORRECT PLACEMENT OF SECTION "B" ON BACK OF ENTRIES.
19. Exhibitors whose work bears a "red sticker" should check at the sales desk that the work has been sold. No responsibility can be accepted in respect of red stickers affixed in error.
20. In the event of a dispute arising regarding the interpretation of these conditions, the decision of the Art Show Committee of the Rotary Clubs of Murray Bridge and Mobilong shall be final and binding on all parties.
21. **Please note that the Mobilong & Murray Bridge Rotary Art Show is not registered for GST.** Artists may be required to supply a tax invoice on request.

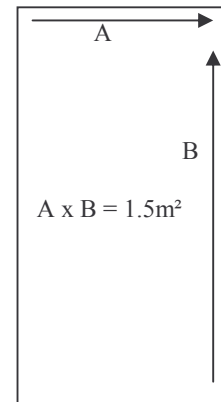
Large works, those between 1.2m² and 1.5m² will incur a premium registration fee of **\$40 per painting**.

4. If you do not quote your ABN, or sign the declaration, we will be obliged to RETAIN 48.5% OF THE SALE PRICE and remit that amount to the ATO.
