CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND SALE FOR CERAMIC WORKS

1. Each artist may enter a maximum of four original uncopied ceramic art-works.
2. **Ceramic works will attract a prize of \$500**
3. The artist is asked to list the entries on the Ceramics Entry Form Section A in the order of priority for display so that if in the event of too many works being received for the space available, the artist's preferred works may be displayed.
4. Each work must have Section "B" of the Entry Form attached to it.
5. Each entrant must complete, sign and post section "A" to **Rotary Art Show, c/- Ron Jericho 2 Leslie Street, Murray Bridge 5253**, with a cheque or money order at the rate of \$10.00 for each entry. **IN THE EVENT THAT A WORK IS NOT SELECTED FOR DISPLAY, THE ENTRY FEE IS NOT REFUNDABLE.**
6. THE ROTARY CLUBS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO EXHIBIT SUCH OF THE ENTRIES AS THE CLUBS SELECT for the period the show is open to the public, and the Clubs shall be entitled to offer any entry for sale to the public at the price endorsed on the work and, in the event of a sale being effected, the Clubs shall be entitled to retain twenty-five per centum of the sale price (exclusive of any GST) as a selling commission. Artists registered for GST will receive the GST component to be forwarded to the Australian Taxation Office.
7. The clubs will exercise all reasonable care in handling the entries submitted, but will not be responsible for the loss of, or damage to any entries while in the custody of the Clubs or Clubs' agents or being sent to or from the Art Show.
ARTISTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR INSURING THEIR WORKS AGAINST LOSS OR DAMAGE.
8. **SPECIAL NOTE:** Entries must be delivered free of all charges. No payments whatsoever will be made by the Clubs for freight, or other charges incurred in delivery or return.
9. Entries selected will be on view to the public for the period of the Art Show.
10. If a competitor fails to remove his or her entry or entries from the designated address as provided in these conditions, the Clubs, after sending by registered post to the competitor at his or her known address one month's notice of the Club's intention to sell or otherwise dispose of such entries, or in the event of the address of the competitor being not known to the Clubs, then one month after advertising notice of such intention in a newspaper, may sell such entry or entries and, after deducting for the proceeds the costs of any incidentals to the sale, shall hold any balance for the competitor PROVIDED however that in the event of such entry or entries being in the opinion of the Clubs unsaleable, the clubs may, in lieu of selling the same, destroy or otherwise dispose of it or them in such a manner as the Clubs may deem fit and thereafter the Clubs shall be under no liability whatever to the competitor in respect of any entry so destroyed or disposed of. Any notice sent by post as aforesaid shall be deemed to have been received by the competitor on the date when it would have been delivered in the ordinary course of post.
11. The Exhibitors in authorizing this entry, accept the Clubs may allow any entries to be reproduced in Newspapers, Magazines, the Show Catalogues, on the **Art Show Web Site**, or by Television or otherwise used for promotional purposes.
12. ENTRIES WILL BE RECEIVED AT THE **MURRAY BRIDGE REGIONAL GALLERY**, SITUATED IN THE TOWN HALL, SIXTH STREET, MURRAY BRIDGE, FROM 9-00 A.M. MONDAY 7 APRIL 2008 AND NO LATER THAN 5PM THE SAME DAY.
IF NOT DELIVERED BY HAND, CONSIGN BY BUS, OR AIR FREIGHT TO MURRAY BRIDGE REGIONAL GALLERY, TOWN HALL, SIXTH STREET, MURRAY BRIDGE, SO AS TO ARRIVE BEFORE 1-00 P.M. ON 6th MARCH 2007
13. ENTRIES MUST BE COLLECTED AT THE MURRAY BRIDGE REGIONAL GALLERY, MURRAY BRIDGE, FROM 10.00AM – 1.00PM SATURDAY 26 April 2008.
14. All works must be for sale. Artists are reminded that price is an important consideration in sales, and should represent good value for the purchaser.
15. Exhibitors whose work bears a "red sticker" should check at the sales desk that the work has been sold. No responsibility can be accepted in respect of red stickers affixed in error.
16. In the event of a dispute arising regarding the interpretation of these conditions, the decision of the Art Show Committee of the Rotary Clubs of Murray Bridge and Mobilong shall be final and binding on all parties.
17. **Please note that the Mobilong & Murray Bridge Rotary Art Show is not registered for GST.** Artists may be required to supply a tax invoice on request.
