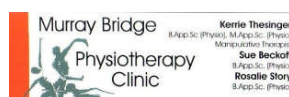
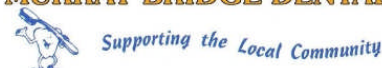
NOTICE BOARD

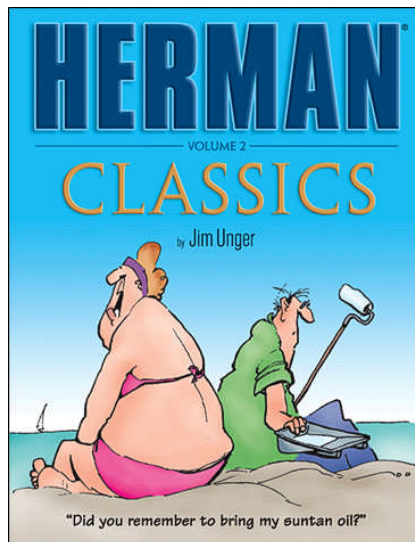
Chairman Marilyn Klem introduced Mark Herselman and Richard Rowland who spoke about the **Life Education** program. Mark showed a short video about the accidental death of a young woman due to a one off ecstasy ingestion. Apart from illicit drugs 1 in 20 drug deaths are the result of the misuse of alcohol and tobacco and accordingly Life education is designed to give children the knowledge and skills to make healthy life choices, in particular regarding the responsible use of alcohol. The presenters visit primary schools in a large bus and tailor the program to suit the particular school. The belief is that spending of limited funds should be on prevention rather than cure, using the slogan "Keep Aussie Kids Safe".

Richard introduced Harold the giraffe in an entertaining demonstration of how the puppet is used as a teaching aid.
