FOR THE GOOD OF ROTARY

- Cherilyn announced that the Christmas Fair will be held on Sunday 14th November, which is less than 6 weeks away. The CFS will be on hand to erect the tents for us, so the manual effort required of us will be much reduced. The Fair has historically been held to allow small organizations to fundraise without too much cost on their part. We have done it to assist them, but still manage to make several thousand dollars for our efforts. Over 3,000 people came to the last Fair. Graham Lough will again be providing his Brontosaurus Burgers which sold out last time.
- Terry will forward an email regarding the Firewood Project activities.
- Tom Davenport announced that the Blackwood Rotary T shirts have arrived, courtesy of the Heads and Tails sessions which have been bankrolled by Graham Lough. Each member will be provided with a shirt, including each new member when inducted. The total cost was \$2,601.50 and funds raised so far are \$1,900. There are two types: the "sublimation" shirt valued at \$50 and the cotton polo for \$25 Graham Lough reminded us of the wine bottling of Maglieri wines to be done on Sunday 24th October. A dodger is being circulated for volunteer tippers.
- Barbara announced that the Planning Session Project has been discussed by the Board and will soon be put before the Club for discussion and ratification.
- John Hunter announced that on 19th October there will be 45 Adelaide Rotary Club members attending for a joint meeting, with guest speakers Geof & Peter Motely. Sergeant Helen asked that because it is a joint meeting we should strive to mix with the Adelaide Club members so that there is a 50:50 ratio per table.
