The raffle was won by **Bob Richter**.

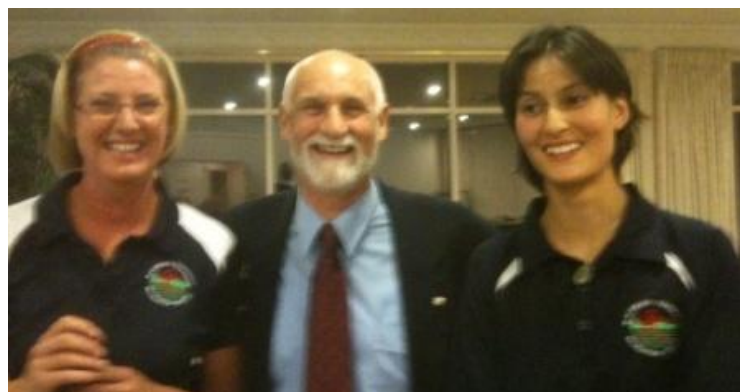
HEADS & TAILS
