Brenda started off her talk by asking the Rotarians what they knew about Red Cross activities. She displayed a list of 10 programs including some of the following:

Youth Engagement, Emergency Services, and Food Security.

The main aim of the Food Security Programs is to build capacity in the most disadvantaged communities with an emphasis on supporting Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders.

The Breakfast Program interrupts a cycle of disadvantage by giving children a good start to the day so they can concentrate on school and go on to get an education that will lead them to employment. There are 255 Breakfast Clubs nationally and 27 of them are in South Australia.
