The conference golf day competition will be a single stableford event open to Rotarians and their partners from District 9600 who have a registered AGU, PNG or SI handicap.

Trophies will be presented for mens and ladies winners and runners up, together with a number of on course prizes.

District Governor Walter Buchanan will present the trophies immediately following the competition.

To promote fellowship and interaction between competitors, all players will be allocated to their playing groups by the organising committee.

All players are required to be at the club by 8.15am so that they can meet the other players in their groups and be on their nominated tee ready for the shotgun start at 9.00am sharp.

The Vic Honour Perpetual Trophy competition is an event for Rotarians only and will be held in conjunction with the conference golf day competition.

The four highest scores achieved by individual players from each club will be used to arrive at an aggregate score for that club. The club with the highest aggregate stableford score will win the Vic Honour Perpetual Trophy.

In the event that two or more clubs have the same aggregate score then a countback will be undertaken using the club's aggregate scores for each hole starting at the 18th hole and working back until a clear winner is determined.

Given the possible difficulty with the far distant clubs from PNG and SI having four golfing members attending the conference, it would be acceptable for PNG and SI clubs, if they wish, to form a composite team to compete for the Vic Honour Perpetual Trophy.

The winner of the Vic Honour Perpetual Trophy will be announced and the trophy presented during the Saturday night social function.
