### **Update from Jack Goodrich**

All is very well as always. I started back at school at the beginning of September. It's really good. I'm in a languages stream so I'm learning (or at last trying to) Dutch, Spanish and German, as well as being in the English class. I also have chemistry, moral studies, French and Mathematics. I go to an external French course three days a week, from 8:30 to 12 so I miss the first half day of school on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday. It's definitely worth it though because that's where I learn most of the new things in French as there isn't a course or subject like that at school.

I haven't had difficulties speaking French for months now, which is relieving to say - however that doesn't mean I don't still learn new things every day though. I'm beginning to read books in French, which is very interesting and demands a far greater base knowledge of the language than reading in English does. The conjugations of all the 14 odd tenses (there are only 6 in English) is what gets me, along with the fact that some of those tenses are not used in speech, but only for literature. It's like learning another third of the language. I quite enjoy it though.

My summer holidays here were spectacular. I went to sailing with my host father for one week in the south of Holland. We docked in numerous ports of which I couldn't even hope to remember the names of all. It's true that Dutch is an extremely similar language to English, but when it comes to names, it's something completely different.

The next things coming up for me are the two Rotary trips in the November holidays. One to Paris for three days, and another to London for four. I am quite looking forward to them.
