### THE FAMILY OF ROTARY MONTH

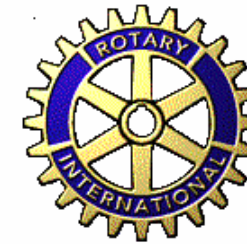

Heard that PP Ray Begovich has undergone a hernia operation recently. We hope that you are now on the road to recovery and back at the meeting real soon.



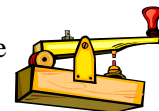
**MAX'S TRIVIA**
