

MAXI'S TRIVIA

The Richter scale was devised in 1935 by Californian Seismologist, Charles Richter. It measure the energy released by an earthquake. The scale is open ended and an increase of 1 point indicates the earthquake force is 10 times greater than the number below, so an earthquake measuring 6 is 10 times greater than 5, 100 times greater than 4 and so on.

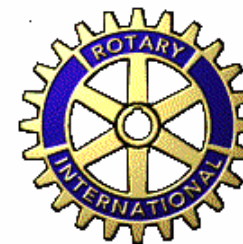
The last 4 months are numbers as early Romans began the year in March.
