and a birthday girl with **Irene Little** celebrating her birthday on Saturday 14th April. Have a great day!

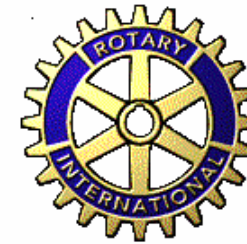
APRIL IS MAGAZINE MONTH
