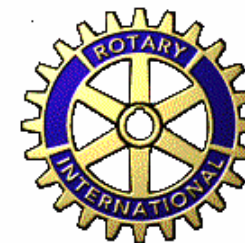
BIRTHDAY AND ANNIVERSARIES
