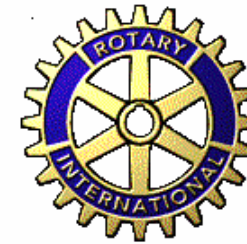

Max’s Trivia

In 1914 the Panama Canal was opened after taking 10 years to build by up to 42,000 workmen (not counting time and effort by the failed French attempt). A ship travelling from the Atlantic side would pass through the 1st lock which raises the water level 26 metres, the second which lowers it 16.5 metres and then the last lock at sea level. A ship travelling from Sydney to New York would save 6000km by using the canal.



In 1973 Egypt and Syria attacked Israel again but in 10 days Israel crossed the Suez into Egypt and invaded Syria. To reduce Western support for Israel, Opec decided to cut oil production by 5% a month until Israel withdrew. Three weeks later it cut production by 25% and continued with 5% a month. In addition, oil companies had to pay an extra 70%. Oil was increased 17% and 3 months later another 50%. Saudi Arabia was one of the originators of using oil as political pressure.
