It is a time to promote membership development within the club (internal extension) and new clubs (external extension). Also to emphasize that club growth is the business of **every Rotarian**.

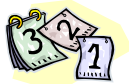


BIRTHDAY AND ANNIVERSARIES

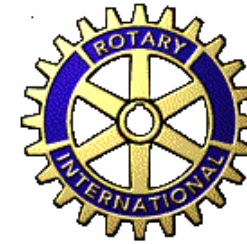
