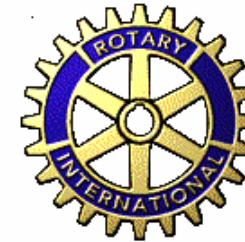
Also **Rtn Gaye Day** will be celebrating her birthday on Tuesday, 28.8.2007 Have a great day Gaye!.
