We have a wedding anniversary on Thursday, 20.9.2007 with **PP John and Geneta Grujovski** celebrating their special day. Have a great day.

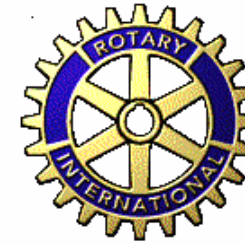


A Club anniversary with **PP Geoff Lumley** being inducted into the club on 23.9.1991 giving him 15 years service to the club.
