We have PP Geoff Lumley celebrating his birthday on Thursday 21.2.2008. Have a great day Geoff.



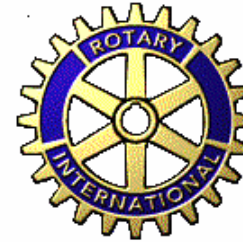
February is World Understanding Month and Peace Day
