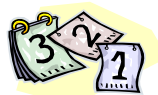

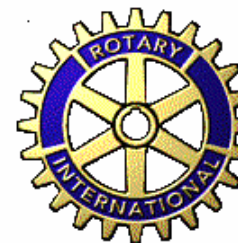
APRIL IS MAGAZINE MONTH
