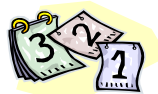

Actually sirloin gets its name from its position in a carcass before removal. In French it is cut from above (sur) the loin (longe) and in English it became sirloin.

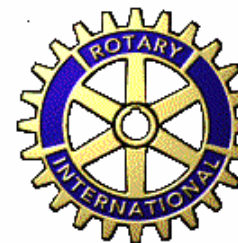
