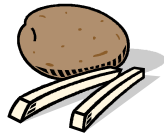
Max's Trivia

Eventually the name was given to all inferior servants and one of their jobs was food and wine tasting. Eventually they became the food and wine connoisseurs.

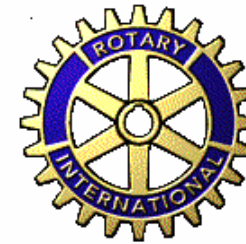
The common name for the Potato—Spud comes from the tools used to dig it up—a short knife known as a spudde.
