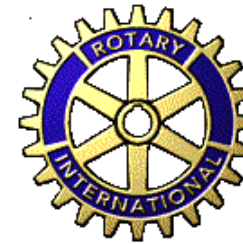
PDG/PP Bill Little celebrated his birthday on 19/6/2010 and Julia Crackau will celebrate hers on Thursday 24th June 2010.
