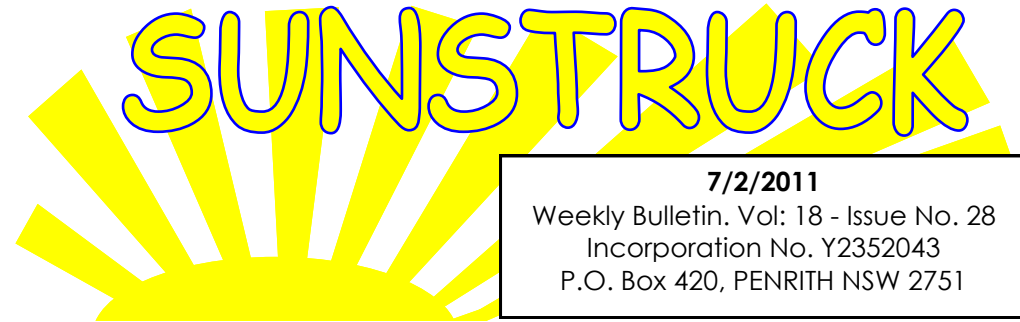
OBJECT OF ROTARY

In joyful strains, then let us sing – Advance Australia Fair.**

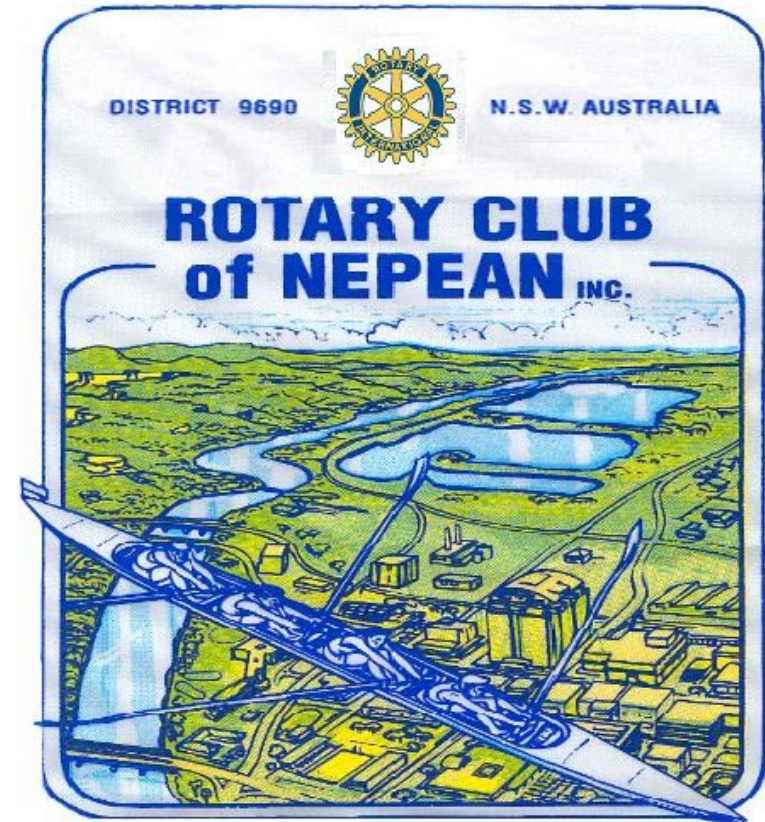
