This week is the Street Fair, also on Saturday. Mostly to try to get rid of some more raffle tickets but with some Rotary things available. See you there.

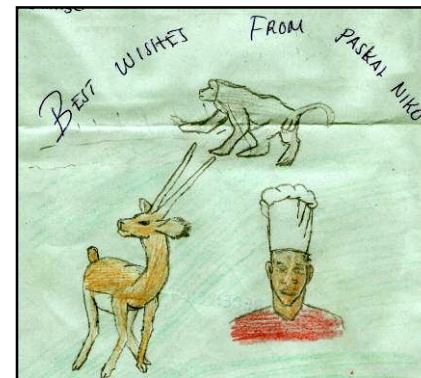


## From Paskal at St Jude
