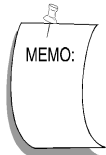

REPORTS

Last week our Club was addressed by Jennifer Burger who works for The Entertainment Company which supports Tasmanian businesses. The Company produces a publication called "The Entertainment Book". The book is offered to not for profit organisations including Rotary Clubs to sell as a fund-raiser. Cyril reported that he had received a letter thanking the Club for our donation to Polio Plus.

In a letter received from our International President, \$US 60m has been raised for Polio Plus to match the grant from the Gates Foundation of \$US355m. The aim now is to make that amount up to \$US555m with the help of Mr Bill Gates.

Cyril reported that Bowel Scan kits will be available from participating chemists from mid- March. Volunteers are needed to assist with testing on the evenings of Wednesday and Thursday each week from mid-March. The point of contact is Rotarian Bill Brundle.
