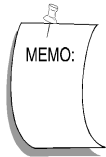

## REPORTS

Last week our Club was addressed by Robert Wise from the French company Veolia which does recycling in Tasmania. He explained that the energy to collect, recycle and manufacture goods is very much cheaper than it is to manufacture those same goods from new raw materials. China is the main customer for recycled paper and plastics. The Clarence City Council has a no waste water into the Derwent River policy. Waste that is not recycled into manufactured goods is converted to fertiliser and distributed throughout the local area. Veolia is branching out into third world countries. Hopefully, that will have good effects for the environment and public health in those countries.
