*Last Week:* The BBQ trailer was 'officially' launched following its 'unofficial', but very successful launch at the Clarence Dogs' Day Out. The 'official' one took the form of a barbecue for



members and partners at the eSchool Southern Campus, where we later were treated to a very informative presentation of what the eSchool is all about, by Terry's wife Lynne Dunne who is Principal Manager, and two of her colleagues

Janine Bowes and Scott Shelton. The school is a K-10 online learning provider offering programs and online courses based on the Tasmanian/Aust curriculum. It is the modern day version of the School of Distance Education. The school enrolls students who meet specific enrolment criteria such as isolation, medical, and pregnancy, enabling the Tasmanian eSchool to be their base school. Students from other schools who require access to a wide range of online courses for curriculum enrichment and extension are also taught by eSchool teachers. Some of the students live in isolated areas of Tasmania but there are also some living overseas for short periods who can also benefit. The school also provides assistance to government schools allowing them to provide courses they may not have specialist teachers for on their own staff, or where there are not enough interested students to warrant having a teacher employed on site. – this is especially beneficial to students in small rural schools who may wish to pursue subjects such as science, foreign languages, music etc. eSchool also provides support through the Hospital Schools Program to school aged patients at RHH and LGH. Parents who are registered as Home Educators also have access to the resources. During the evening we learnt a new vocabulary and worked our way through Moodle including a sort of question and answer test which gives participants instant feedback - we are a clever lot as we got 100%!!!. The facilities at the eSchool are open to use by organisations and groups for meetings, use of the computers etc. It is a wonderful facility and should prove a popular venue For more info visit: [www.tasmanianeschool.tas.edu.au](http://www.tasmanianeschool.tas.edu.au)
