Last Week: Tony South from Paraplegic Benefit Fund. Tony has been a paraplegic since he was 9 years old, but that hasn't stopped him getting on with living! Some of his achievements include World Paraplegic Archery Champion 1968-72, a representative at 4 Olympic and Commonwealth Games, 1986 Disabled Achiever of Year, Qld, 1991 Order of Australia Medal – service to community, 2007-8 President RC Mt Gravatt. Paraplegic Benefit Fund's aim is primarily to prevent injury as a way of addressing the spinal injury problem in Australia, by either preventing it, curing it or funding it. The PBF is a not-for-profit organisation working to address the financial, physical and emotional cost of spinal cord injury. Members are eligible to apply for a \$100,000 benefit payment if they sustain a permanent spinal injury, which helps pay for some of the many early costs, including ongoing medical and rehab costs and modifications to house and car. The organisation aims to reduce the number of serious injuries and deaths on the road, at work and in the aquatic environment through education and awareness programs.
