*From the Board:*

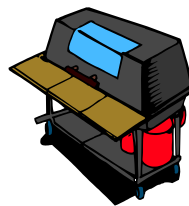
Subs for 2011-12 will be **REDUCED** to \$140, or \$70 per 6 months. These are now due
